About 50 millions bottles of wine worldwide annually poured down the sink. The culprit is TCA (trichloroanisol) which through contaminated cork in the wine passes. Unfortunately, you notes these evil cork smell when it's to late already, to opening the some-times longstored bottles.

Studies shows that 4-12 % of wines on the market with TCA contaminated Have a very uglyhidden " cork ". Low cork influence which you not notice by the first sip. What the end user are simply drinks.

Scientifically speaking, there is no benefits of premium natural cork compared with screw caps.

The cork in the wine undergoes 100 % air exhaust statements. The air remaining in the bottle is enough to get the wine to develop and store.

Unfortunately most expensive class Natural cork TCA affected .

Screw caps also provide a protect hermetic airtight,like flavors , freshness and fruit, are resistant to atmospheric fluctuations. They are neutral and eliminate the likelihood of a training exchanges.
